AWARD OF NON-GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIPS AND FREE-SHIPS

(POLICY DOCUMENT)

Sultan-ul-Uloom College of Pharmacy is committed to promote and support higher education opportunities for students from diverse backgrounds. In recognition of the importance of financial aid in facilitating access to quality education, the institution has established a policy framework for the fair and transparent distribution of non-government scholarships and free ships. This policy document outlines the guidelines, procedures and criteria for the awarding of scholarships and free-ships.

Objectives

The objectives of this policy are as follows:

- a) To encourage and reward academic excellence, recognizing outstanding achievements by students at Sultan-ul-Uloom College of Pharmacy.
- b) To provide financial assistance to students from poor backgrounds, enabling them to pursue higher education.
- c) To promote a diverse and inclusive student community by supporting students with exceptional talents in sports, cultural activities or other areas of achievement.
- d) To foster a culture of research, innovation and creativity by offering scholarships to students engaged in cutting-edge projects.
- e) To ensure transparency, fairness and accountability in the process of awarding scholarships and free-ships.

Types of Scholarships and Free-ships

Sultan-ul-Uloom College of Pharmacy offers the following types of scholarships and free-ships:



- a) **Merit Scholarships**: These scholarships are awarded to students based on their academic performance, including grade point average (GPA) or equivalent measures of academic achievement. The selection committee will assess the academic records of eligible students to determine the recipients.
- b) **Need-Based Scholarships**: These scholarships are awarded to students who are in grave financial need. A comprehensive assessment of the applicant's family income, assets and other relevant factors will be conducted to determine eligibility. The selection committee will consider the financial circumstances of the applicants and prioritize those with the greatest need.
- c) Sports and Cultural Scholarships: These scholarships are awarded to students who excel in sports, cultural activities or other talents recognized by university. Applicants will be required to demonstrate their achievements and potential through documented evidence and performance evaluations.
- d) Research and Innovation Scholarships: These scholarships are awarded to students engaged in research, innovation or creative projects that contribute to their field of study. Applicants will be required to submit a detailed research proposal or project plan, along with supporting documents demonstrating their capacity for research or innovation.
- e) **Free-ships**: Free ships provide partial or full tuition fee waivers to students who meet the prescribed eligibility criteria. These criteria may include academic performance, financial need or other specified criteria as determined by the institution.

Application and Selection Process

- a) The institution will announce the availability of scholarships and free ships through official channels, including the university website, notice boards and relevant communication platforms.
- b) Interested students must submit a formal application along with the required supporting documents within the stipulated deadline. The application process will be clearly outlined in the announcement.
- c) A selection committee comprising of Management, Principal and faculty members will be constituted to review and evaluate the applications. The committee will follow a fair and transparent selection process based on the specified criteria for each scholarship/free-ship category.
- d) The selection committee will conduct interviews, examinations or any other evaluation methods deemed necessary to assess the applicant's eligibility and suitability for the scholarships and free-ships.
- e) The final selection will be based on merit, need or specific criteria as applicable to each category. The committee's decision will be communicated to the selected students in writing, including details of the scholarship/free ship award and any terms and conditions associated with it.

Terms and Conditions

- a) Scholarship and free ship recipients must maintain satisfactory academic progress as defined by the institution throughout the duration of their studies. Failure to meet the academic requirements may result in the withdrawal of the scholarship/free-ship.
- b) Recipients are expected to adhere to the code of conduct and disciplinary policies of Sultan-ul-Uloom College of Pharmacy.
- c) Scholarships and free-ships are generally awarded for a specific academic year or a defined period. Renewal of the award for subsequent years may be subject to continued eligibility and satisfactory performance.
- d) Recipients may be required to participate in specific activities or events organized by the institution, such as mentoring programs, community service or research projects.
- e) The institution reserves the right to review, modify or terminate any scholarship or free ship based on changes in financial circumstances, policy revisions or other relevant factors.

Review and Evaluation

The institution will periodically review the effectiveness and impact of the scholarship and free ship policy. The review process will involve collecting feedback from stakeholders, analysing data on the recipient's academic progress, achievements and making necessary adjustments to improve the policy's outcomes.

Dispute Resolution

In case of any disputes or grievances related to the awarding of scholarships and free ships, students can avail themselves of the institution's established grievance redressal mechanisms. The institution will ensure a fair and transparent process for addressing complaints and resolving disputes.
