Green Campus/Plastic Free Policy Document



Introduction:

At Sultan-ul-Uloom College of Pharmacy, we aim to create a sustainable and environmental-friendly campus by minimizing plastic waste and promoting a green campus. This policy aims to reduce the college's environmental impact, protect ecosystems, and educate and engage students, faculty, staff, and stakeholders regarding the importance of plastic waste reduction and green-campus initiatives.

Objectives:

- To reduce the use of single-use plastics. and implement plastic-free alternatives
- To develop effective waste management practices that prioritize recycling and proper disposal
 of plastic waste.
- To raise awareness and educate the students, faculty and staff on the benefits of green campus initiatives through plantation drives, water harvesting.

Policy Guidelines:

- **a.Waste Management:** Sultan-ul-Uloom College of Pharmacy has established a comprehensive waste management system that includes waste segregation, proper disposal of waste materials, recycling, and reduction of waste generation.
 - Waste Segregation: The College maintains separate bins for the collection of wet and dry
 wastes.
 - Paperless Office: Sultan-ul-Uloom College of Pharmacy promotes e-communication to minimize paper usage. We encourage using social media platforms such as What's App for notices and circulars and Facebook, Instagram, and Twitter for Cooperative Social Responsibility.
 - Recycling: The college has an MOU for solid waste and e-waste with RAPIDUE TECHNOLOGY Pvt. Ltd (Reeykal) and for biomedical waste with MARADI Agency to recycle the generated waste.
 - E-Waste Management: The Institution repairs and updates out-dated computer systems.
 Computers, electrical and electronic instruments that are not in working condition are disposed of through scrap dealers by adopting a transparent system.
- **b. Plastic Free Campus:** Sultan-ul-Uloom College of Pharmacy aims to reduce plastic waste and implement eco-friendly and sustainable practices.

- Sustainable Alternatives: The college facilitates eco-friendly substitutes, such as the use of steel and glass bottles instead of plastic bottles. Cloth bags and jute bags were used to minimize plastic use.
- Awareness and Education: The institution will organize campaigns, workshops and events to
 raise awareness and educate the campus community on plastic waste reduction strategies and
 alternatives.
- **c.** Water Management: SUCP aims to minimize water consumption, promote responsible water use, and ensure water conservation by implementing efficient measures.
 - Rain Water Harvesting: The college utilizes rainwater harvesting pits to recharge groundwater and to maintain green cover on the campus
 - Borewell: The College maintains wells to utilize groundwater for watering plants and maintaining the garden.
 - Maintenance and Monitoring: The institution maintains its water bodies and distribution system and monitors them quarterly and annually.
- **d** Plantation Drive: Sultan-ul-Uloom College of Pharmacy aims to promote environmental sustainability, enhance green spaces, and contribute to the conservation and beautification of the college campus. Sucp encourages staff and students to actively participate in planting sapling initiatives, such as the Haritha Haram Program. The plant sapling drives are undertaken by the NSS and SBA units of the college.
- **e.** Compliance and Review: All members of the college community are expected to comply with this policy and support its implementation.
 - Monitoring and Evaluation: We will regularly monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of our environmental practices.
 - Policy Review: This policy will be reviewed periodically to ensure that it remains updated with best standards and practices.
