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

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

SUMMARY:

The analysis of student feedback revealed several key insights. A significant majority of students (77%) rated the teachers' command over the subject matter as excellent, while 45% expressed that the syllabus is covered uniformly in an excellent manner during classes. The use of teaching aids received predominantly positive responses, with most students considering them very good or good. Additionally, 70% of students rated the evaluation procedures as excellent, reflecting strong satisfaction. Faculty accessibility and commitment were also positively acknowledged, emphasizing their valuable contribution to academic performance; however, students suggested improvements in preparedness and presentation during lectures. Regarding campus facilities, the library and canteen were generally rated as satisfactory, and over 50% of students found the sports facilities to be very good. Overall, the facilities offered by the college received a very good rating, highlighting a positive perception among students.





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ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON FEEDBACK - STUDENTS





SUMMARY:

The analysis of feedback from our alumni revealed compelling insights. They highlighted the exceptional foundational knowledge gained during their course, which effectively equipped them to analyse complex problems. 74% of alumni reported successfully addressing health, ethical, and relevant issues in their professional roles, reflecting the practical value of their education. 46% of alumni praised the excellence of their involvement in social and welfare activities, demonstrating their active participation in community-oriented initiatives. Only 20% of alumni rated their ability to follow current regulatory guidelines as *excellent*, indicating the need for focused efforts in this area. Despite some areas needing attention, 56% of alumni expressed overall satisfaction with the excellent training provided at the institution. Few suggestions received were to increase student involvement in social activities, organize inter college competitions, provide information about opportunities for higher studies. Encourage students to participate in innovative idea competitions.



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



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SUMMARY:

Based on the analysis of the pie charts, the majority of students (71%) believe that the teachers possess an excellent command over the subject matter. Regarding the coverage of the syllabus during classes, 41% of students find it as excellently covered. The utilization of teaching aids response from students showed that teachers need o be more motivated to use the teaching aids effectively. Furthermore, 64% of students consider the evaluation procedure to be excellent.

The commitment of the faculty has received positive feedback from most students, which is recognized as a valuable contribution to their academic performance. However, there are some areas identified for improvement based on student feedback. The accessibility aspect was reported by few as unsatisfactory, while the preparedness and presentation were rated as satisfactory.

In summary, the feedback indicates a generally positive perception of teachers' subject matter expertise, satisfactory syllabus coverage. The commitment of the faculty is seen as beneficial to students' academic performance. However, improvements are needed in terms of accessibility, usage of teaching aids as well as enhancing preparedness and presentation skills.

The utilization of teaching aids has garnered predominantly positive responses, with over 70% of students rating it as very good or above. Furthermore, 78% of students consider the evaluation procedure to be excellent.

The commitment of the faculty has received positive feedback from most students, which is recognized as a valuable contribution to their academic performance. However, there are some areas identified for improvement based on student feedback. The accessibility aspect was reported as unsatisfactory, while the preparedness and presentation were rated as satisfactory.

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SUMMARY:



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

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
