Introduction:

In this Scheme the institution provides financial support to the staff to attend conferences/workshops/seminars/FDPs/symposia at college/national/international level in pharmaceutical field as well as to obtain professional membership of the relevant field. Support is also extended to non-teaching staff to attend skill upgradation programs.

Objectives:

- To exchange their ideas in the field of research, innovation and entrepreneurship.
- To establish a healthy teaching-learning platform
- To upgrade the professional skills.

Eligibility:

Financial assistance is provided for full time teaching faculty and non-teaching staff of the institute.

Type of Assistance Available Under the Scheme:

Financial assistance is provided to the faculty

- For purchase of glassware/chemicals in carrying out Research Projects/Ph.D. works.
- To attend State/National/International level FDPs/ Research Works/ Seminars/ Workshops/ Conferences/ Symposia in the field of pharmaceutical sciences.
- to obtain professional membership of the relevant field on seniority basis.
- to take up research projects and publish articles in the refereed journals/ UGC care list journals

Procedures to apply for the scheme:

- Requirement letter of glassware/chemicals/stock submitted by the staff approved by the principal submitted to stores in-charge to carry out research work.
- Faculty attending a conference/FDP/workshop/symposium should provide an approval from principal with an attachment of Registration form and submit the certificate after completion of the course.
- For filing patents
- For writing books and chapters in books

Procedures to avail Financial Support:

- Chemicals/Glassware will be issued by store in charge on requirement after approval by head of the institution.
- Faculty will be supported with registration amount paid towards conference/FDP/workshop/ symposia after submitting the certificate of participation with registration brochure to the institution within 3 days.
